What you'll be doing

We take a lot of pride in delivering great looking and tasting veg boxes and recipe boxes to our customers. We will be providing the raw root products that will go into these boxes, working on the wet grading line or the dry grading line. Based at Roots Production in Landscove and be part of existing team of co-owners working with root products.

Roots Grading Team

The Roots team is based on an agricultural site over two barns, the conditions can be cold in winter and warm in the summer, correct PPE will be provided, you do need to be in comfortable working in cold and warm conditions as well as being on your feet for long periods of time. In this role you will use your initiative and attention to detail to make sure that you are only grading the very best produce for our packing teams at our Wash site.

You'll provide ongoing support to the team leader, working collaboratively to keep the department running smoothly, helping with the day to day management of the team as well as stepping up and taking on more responsibility when the team leader is absent.

Your responsibilities

- Ensuring accurate and timely completion of daily production requirements
- Prompt communication of any problems or issues across all departments; always ensuring dispatch and procurement are kept up to date.
- Delivering high quality well-presented produce; constantly monitoring quality and accuracy and considering our customers' needs to produce a well presented extras item.
- To assist the team leader in holding a weekly meeting with your team explaining new products, changes in product specification and explaining anything else which they may need to know and listening to feedback.
- Ensure accurate completion of timesheets and attendance records for your department
- Assist in introducing new members of the team and carry out the departmental part of the induction, completing the necessary paperwork and returning it to HR
- Resource management; making sure the area is properly resourced with the staff and materials required for the day and weeks work.
- Attend any workshops and training as requested to aid your development.
- Assist in other areas of the business as required.
