What you'll be doing

This role is a day shift within Riverford's Sacrewell site. The Goods In area is a hive of activity, in this role you will working with and forging relationships with a variety of people and departments. Working as part of Goods In team, this position forms a key role in maintaining the efficient flow of goods into our site whilst maintaining quality and safety standards.

As a Goods In Team Member the role will require you to be working in an outdoor environment as well as inside large cold stores and open indoor areas. You'll be responsible for the movement of pallets and bulk bins between these areas as well as the safe loading and unloading of daily deliveries and returning loads, providing a quick turnaround where needed as well as managing the space.

As part of the sites overall stock management process, daily stock counts may form part of your working day as well as the arranging produce deliveries into designated areas for processing.

Due to the nature of the products and the role, this position will involve regular lifting, manual handling in addition to the regular and safe use of pallet trucks.

Other roles include the collation of recycling and waste ready for loading off site and ensuring the grade out produced daily is disposed of in a timely manner. In the winter months there is an added requirement to ensure the yard and surrounding areas are salted.

This is a permanent contract, working 39 hours per week usually Sunday to Thursday between the hours between 5am & 5pm. Based at our site on Sacrewell Farm, Peterborough. PE8 6HJ

Your responsibilities

- Provide a welcoming feel to suppliers and hauliers, you will often be the first face they will see so it is important that you are approachable and helpful.
- Assisting in the organisation of the of Yard areas, ensuring a tidy environment is maintained and any hazards are identified and managed/removed
- Observing all company health and safety policies.
- Safely loading and unloading daily deliveries from despatch loading bays and moving them to correct refrigerated storage areas.
- Using a truck to unload pallets of recycling and trays and storing them safely in the designated areas.
- Use of electrical lifting equipment to unload vehicles of produce and storing them safely in designated areas.
- To be part of the stock management processes; counting stock and the booking in of goods.
- Enforcing compliance with farm site rules i.e.: Vehicular movements, speed and access and ensuring everyone is adhering to these.
- Looking after the trucks and other equipment provided, reporting any damage or incident to your Team Manager.
- Be an active part of the sites housekeeping processes, adopting a clean as you go working method whilst working to scheduled cleaning tasks.
- In quiet times providing support other areas as required which may include grading or packing products.

- Experience of and operation of mechanised lifting equipment in busy environments is beneficial.
- Some experience with IT systems. Familiar with Microsoft suit or similar stock management systems would be an advantage.
- Experience of working in a warehouse and or production facility.
- Excellent communication and people skills together with time management and organisation skills.
