What you'll be doing

We take a lot of pride in delivering great looking and tasting veg boxes and recipe boxes to our customers. We will be providing the raw root products that will go into these boxes, working on the wet grading line or the dry grading line. Based at Roots Production in Landscove and be part of existing team of co-owners working with root products.

Roots Grading Team

Sorting through various root crops (potatoes, carrots, onions, parsnips, beetroot, swede, and Jerusalem artichokes) and assess the quality and size of the crop throughout the year and ensuring we provide a continued supply of high-quality produce to our pack house. The Roots team is based on an agricultural site over two barns, the conditions can be cold in winter and warm in the summer, correct PPE will be provided, you do

need to be in comfortable working in cold and warm conditions as well as being on your feet for long periods of time.

In either role you will use your initiative and attention to detail to make sure that you are only grading the very best produce for our packing teams at our Wash site. You may be asked to help in other departments, or muck in and help with keeping the production area clean and tidy, so you will need to be generally enthusiastic and keen to work as part of a team to get the job done.

This is a 6 month Fixed Term Contract, 39 hours per week, 5 days per week. Monday -Thursday: 07:00-15:30 – Friday: 07:00-14:30 Based out of our Roots Production site at Hayllors Blacker, Barton Farm, Landscove, Ashburton, TQ13 7LZ.

Your responsibilities

Your responsibilities will vary, but could include some of the following:

Assist in the completion of the daily purchase orders ensuring that quality, accuracy and productivity are maintained:

- Monitor quality and size of produce to help produce a high-quality product for our boxes
- Work as a team member and help others.
- Adhere to standard GDPR regulations
- Assist with machine maintenance and cleaning as required.
- Maintain a high level of housekeeping.
- Ensure all site rules and manual handling guidelines, including wearing safety footwear and general behaviour are adhered to.
- Assist with stocktakes if required
- Attend any workshops and training as requested to aid your development
- Assist in all areas of the business as required.

- You must be able to lift and manoeuvre crates of produce and veg boxes
