What you'll be doing

Riverford delivers fresh, seasonal, organic food to thousands of customers weekly across the UK. Our procurement team plays a vital role in maintaining the exceptional standards we are known for, sourcing ethically, sustainably, and commercially.

Long-established supplier relationships are integral to Riverford's success. We work over the long term with our suppliers, creating partnerships built on mutual trust and shared benefits. Being commercially astute and securing competitive pricing is essential, but we should always achieve this respectfully, valuing our suppliers and reflecting our core business ethos.

As we restructure our Supply Chain and Procurement functions — clearly defining roles across Planning, Procurement, and Supply Chain Management — this newly created Procurement Manager role will be key to Riverford's future. You'll lead the delivery of our day-to-day buying function, oversee relationships with direct suppliers, support implementation of procurement strategy, and ensure products across fresh produce, chilled and ambient goods, and ingredients are sourced to meet our commercial, ethical, and sustainability goals.

This is a people leadership role — you'll manage a team of Category Buyers, guiding their development and fostering a collaborative, values-led culture. You'll set clear goals, support coowners' growth, and create space for progression. We're looking for someone as excited by how a team grows as by what it delivers. This role includes budgetary responsibility, line management, and custodianship of our direct procurement processes. You'll need strong commercial acumen, negotiation skills, market insight, and a proactive approach to managing supplier performance and procurement risk. Based predominantly on-site at Wash Farm in Devon (minimum four days per week), the role also includes regular travel to growers and suppliers across the UK and Europe. These visits are vital to building strong relationships, supporting quality, and aligning suppliers with Riverford's values and standards.

This is a permanent position. The role is 40 hours per week. Based on Wash Farm, Buckfastleigh, Devon, TQ11 0JU.

Your responsibilities

Leadership & Team Development

- Lead, coach, and support a team of Category Buyers responsible for procuring Riverford's product range fresh produce, chilled and ambient goods, ingredients, and packaging.
- Build a collaborative, high-performing team culture aligned with Riverford's values.
- Provide clear objectives, feedback, and structured development plans to support professional growth.
- Balance strong commercial and performance expectations with a fair, kind, and supportive approach building a team that is outcome-driven, efficient, and commercially focused, while staying true to Riverford's belief that business can (and should) be collaborative, fun, and values-led.

Procurement Delivery & Budget Management

- Manage Riverford's direct procurement budget, working with your team to ensure efficient category spend and identify cost optimisation opportunities.
- Lead annual and seasonal price negotiations with suppliers, preparing and supporting your team to do the same.
- Oversee the operational delivery of procurement plans aligned with business needs consolidating weekly volumes, securing volume discounts, and optimising logistics.
- Track and report on procurement performance against agreed targets, using data to inform decisions.

Supplier Relationship & Performance Management

- Build and maintain ethical, sustainable, and commercially sound supplier relationships, working within Riverford's Supplier Charter.
- Manage supplier performance using clear KPIs, working with your team to ensure timely interventions and continuous improvement.
- Represent Riverford in key supplier conversations and site visits, ensuring our standards and values are consistently upheld.

Procurement Planning & Market Insight

- Deliver procurement activities in line with seasonal plans and longer-term strategies developed with senior Procurement, Supply Chain, Range, and Planning teams.
- Lead structured tendering and supplier selection processes where applicable, ensuring fairness and transparency.
- Conduct ongoing market analysis to monitor risks, opportunities, and pricing trends, contributing insights to support procurement planning.
- Support supply chain risk management by maintaining proactive contingency plans and securing continuity of supply.

Inventory & Order Management

- Work closely with the Supply Chain team and contribute to the SIOP process to align procurement with demand planning.
- Take ownership of the purchase order process ensuring accuracy, efficiency, and timely delivery of stock to meet operational needs.

Compliance, Quality & Sustainability

- Ensure all procured products meet Riverford's standards including organic certification, food safety, and ethical sourcing.
- Stay informed about relevant legislation, certifications, and sustainability requirements, ensuring supplier compliance.
- Collaborate with Technical, Quality, and ESG teams to deliver high-integrity sourcing.

Development & Progression

The successful candidate will lead Riverford's direct buying operations, and with support and development, will have the opportunity to progress with additional responsibilities — including shaping sourcing strategy, leading major supplier negotiations, and taking on broader commercial or supply chain leadership.
