

What you'll be doing

You will work collaboratively with the Head of Engineering, the Compliance & Standards Manager and Maintenance Manager to ensure a joined-up approach across all engineering activities. Working alongside your counterparts, you'll bring specialist focus on industrialisation, capital projects, and equipment development to ensure a balanced, efficient, and resilient engineering function.

Your primary responsibility will be supporting engineering and capital expenditure projects across the entire business within the Engineering function. You'll build robust business cases, analyse return on investment, and ensure projects are delivered on time, within budget, and with measurable benefits to efficiency, reliability, sustainability, and safety.

A key part of the role will be using data and analysis to steer decision-making: identifying which assets require increased maintenance, which equipment should be prioritised for servicing, and where replacement will deliver the most value. You will also use equipment performance data to demonstrate how new machines and

automation projects can increase efficiency, reduce downtime, improve safety performance, and strengthen Riverford's capability to scale as the business continues to grow.

Alongside this, you will manage a small team that extends engineering support and improvement work to the Riverford Home Delivery (RHD) hubs and the Farm. Here, your remit is to apply structured planning, preventative maintenance, and logical project sequencing, ensuring these areas benefit from the same professional approach, compliance, and business continuity as the rest of the business.

This is a varied and hands-on role: from shaping large-scale CAPEX investments and automation projects, to embedding Early Equipment Management (EEM) principles, developing Planned Preventative Maintenance (PPM) strategies, and ensuring strong project governance. By looking across the entire business within the Engineering function – production, RHD, and Farm – you'll deliver a joined-up, data-driven, safe, and well-planned engineering approach that underpins Riverford's long-term growth and sustainability

The role is 40 hours per week. Normal hours are Monday to Friday. Based at Wash Farm, Buckfastleigh, Devon, TQ11 0JU, with some travel to other Riverford locations as required.

Your responsibilities

Project & Capital Expenditure Delivery

- Personally manage large-scale or technically complex projects, ensuring completion within agreed time, cost, scope, and safety requirements.
- Lead and deliver engineering and capital projects across the business, from initial scoping and business case through to commissioning and handover safely and right first time.
- Present and support the build of robust business cases, clearly demonstrating ROI and alignment with Riverford's long-term strategy.
- Apply strong governance, ensuring the Capital Management process is understood, deployed, and executed in line with company standards.
- Monitor and control capital investment spending, ensuring alignment with budgets, cashflow, and lifecycle planning.
- Collaborate with procurement and suppliers to maximise value, secure best-fit solutions, and ensure compliance with safety, quality, and sustainability standards.
- Work in collaboration with the team to reduce waste, energy use, and our overall environmental impact.

Equipment Industrialisation & Lifecycle Management

• Apply Early Equipment Management (EEM) principles to optimise equipment design, reliability, maintainability, and safety performance.

- Support the development and validation of new equipment, managing trials, commissioning, and handover to operations.
- Drive the full equipment lifecycle process, from development and testing to standardisation, upgrades, and replacement planning.
- Ensure new investments and upgrades are planned with business continuity in mind (e.g. phasing installs to minimise downtime).

Maintenance Support & PPM Development

- Use equipment performance data to shape maintenance priorities and inform servicing and replacement schedules.
- Support the development of Planned Preventative Maintenance (PPM) strategies across the engineering function.
- Provide technical expertise to assist with reactive maintenance and breakdown resolution.
- Introduce best-practice approaches to reduce downtime, extend asset life, and improve safety performance.

Continuous Improvement & Efficiency

- Identify opportunities for automation, mechanisation, and process improvements that enhance efficiency, reliability, and safety.
- Support the "Improving Tomorrow Together" (ITT) continuous improvement programme.
- Share knowledge and coach teams to embed CI tools, project management best practice, and engineering excellence.
- Support the team's development & capability in project management/automation skills.

- Strong knowledge of automation, industrial equipment, and engineering lifecycle management.
- Demonstrable ability to create and present high-quality business cases with clear ROI analysis.

- Experience in governance and capital management processes, including budget control and lifecycle cashflow planning.

- Previous experience in Project Management, Engineering, FMCG, logistics, or manufacturing is advantageous.
